The UAF Faculty Senate moves that the following policy be adopted:

Attendance:

UAF is committed to student success and academic achievement. It is expected to adhere to the class attendance policies set by your instructor.

General Absences: If you miss class, you are responsible for ~~arranging with your instructor as soon as possible concerning your absence, and to discuss the possibility of compensating for the missed work.~~ ~~some departments drop students from their classes if they do not receive approval for the absence.~~


UAF-Sanctioned Absences: If you are scheduled to miss class in an official capacity (e.g., NCAA activities), notify your instructor in writing by the first Wednesday of the semester in which the absences will occur. The notification should include the signature of a UAF school official.

Instructors are encouraged to make reasonable accommodations for students who have an official, UAF-recognized activity. If you are unable to fulfill your responsibility to follow up for notification of absence, discussing an alternative arrangement with your instructor by the second Friday of the semester is strongly recommended. Your best effort, you and your instructor may range for a favorable resolution that will be successful in the end.

Effective: Spring 2017

Rationale: Due to scheduling

Monday instead of a Thursday, instead of the previous class day. This will still allow enough time for students to notify their instructors of their participation in official, UAF-recognized activities.
