

~~Grading policy on the grade “C”~~ grades was modified at Meeting #191 on May 6, 2013. The

C- (1.7) shall be the minimum acceptable grade that **undergraduate** students may receive for courses to count toward the major or minor degree requirements, or as a prerequisite for another course.

The modified policy is effective beginning Fall 2013.

Grade / Grade Points	Definition and academic implications
	“C” (including C+ and C-) indicates a satisfactory level of acquired knowledge and performance in completion of course requirements.
C+ (2.3)	<b>C- (1.7) is the <u>minimum</u> acceptable grade that undergraduate</b>
C (2.0)	<b>students may receive for courses to count toward the major or</b>
C- (1.7)	<b>minor degree requirements, or as a prerequisite for another course. A minimum grade of C (2.0), however, MAY be required by specific programs for prerequisite and / or major / minor courses. Please</b>
