Guidance on Faculty Governance

- 1) Election of the Faculty Senate

- 2) The Dean/Director's Office should have a representative on the Faculty Senate
- 3) The Dean/Director's Office should have a representative on the Faculty Senate
- 4) **NON-ACADEMIC**
Dean/Director's Office should have a representative on the Faculty Senate
 - Tenure-track, research, and other full-time faculty are represented on the Faculty Senate, and may participate in the election process
 - Part-time faculty are not represented on the Faculty Senate and should not participate in the election process
 - Faculty with joint appointments are represented on the Faculty Senate and should participate in the election process
 - In accordance with the Faculty Handbook (GILBERT, 2011), there is no representation of research institutions on the Faculty Senate
 - Faculty with joint appointments are represented on the Faculty Senate and should participate in the election process
- 5) Election of the Dean/Director's Office should have a representative on the Faculty Senate
